An UNWANTED animal is an OWNED animal.

An OWNED animal is classified as:

Within Eugene city limits: being cared for for 90 days or more.

Within Un-incorporated Lane county: being cared for for 45 days or more.

If someone is wanting to get rid of their animal for behavior reasons ask if they have tried behavior modification or training.

Refer to behavior sheet for suggestions!

The following information is current and applicable to the best of our knowledge.

1. Social Networking: All friends, friends of friends, relatives, friends of relatives, co-workers, friends of co-workers should be asked.
2. Craigslist: All posts should have photos and good descriptions of pet and their personalities and habits. **Caution**: owners should screen callers well as some people are dishonest and will use Kittens and puppies for reptile food, sell them to labs or use them as bait for dog fights.
3. Newspaper Ad: Register Guard runs ads for pets for sale and free animal ads, There are fees for both types of ad. **Caution**: owners should screen callers well as some people are dishonest and will use Kittens and puppies for reptile food, sell them to labs or use them as bait for dog fights.
4. Greenhill: People must call to get on the waiting list. They must have owned or cared for the animal for a minimum of 3 months. The wait is usually fairly long

5. Oregon Humane: People must call for an appointment to take their animals up to this Portland humane society. OHS has an excellent 90% adoption rate for cats! During high intake months, they will not take animals from out of their area, call for more information. **FEES APPLY** (503) 416-2994
6. Cat Adoption Team (C.A.T.): People must call for an appointment to take their animals to this Portland area shelter.
